2ND SEMESTER 2019/2020 ACADEMIC CALENDAR TO BE RELEASED SOON

The academic calendar for Second Semester 2019/2020 will be released soon! In his updates to the Joint Council and Faculty Senate Meeting, Dr. Moses Zinnah, Acting Vice President for Academic Affairs, said his office would soon release the calendar. He said next semester is expected to start on March 23. He further said clearing of Category One students for the December 2020 Graduation would start on March 23 thru April 24, and for Category Two, it would start from April 27 thru September 30. Dr. Nelson emphasized that there will be no clearing of students after September 30. Students are advised to take note of these dates.
